Job description

The Commissioning Engineer will be confirming the performance of the equipment on site, based on the contractual agreement and hand it over to the customer incl. required documentation.

In the beginning you will be working in Aalborg, and have side by side training, so you can gain knowledge about our equipment and technology. You will initially be supported by a colleague and after a training period you will be handling the task independently.

Responsibilities/Tasks:

- Work with Project Managers to start up and hand over Raslystation equipment to our customers worldwide. This could also involve providing process support, service support and coordinating process testing / equipment trials.
- Prepare equipment for operation according to manufacturers and engineers' documentation.
- Optimize operation through testing, adjustments, and production runs
- Perform customer training with operations and maintenance personnel on site. Explain the function and performance of the equipment in classroom events and hands on at the machinery
- Responsible for the continuous improvement and maintenance of the standard handover form and processes related to the ISO 9001 certification
